Learning Objective:

1. To celebrate the birth anniversaries of two most memorable personalities, Lal Bahadur Shastri and Mahatma Gandhi and creating an opportunity to make everybody familiar with their teachings and practices.

Gandhi Jayanti is celebrated on 2nd October every year to commemorate the birth anniversary of national icons Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi- an Indian lawyer, anti-colonial nationalist and political ethicist and Lal Bahadur Shahstri. Aakriti club in collaboration with the Apertura Club, JIMS Vasant Kunj celebrated the life journey of Mahatma Gandhi and remembered Sh. Lal Bahadur Shastri on the on October 1st, 2021.
