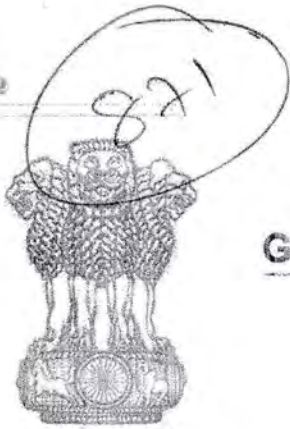

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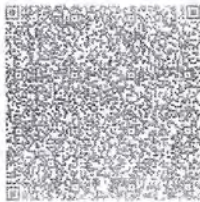

This Deed of trust executed on this 25th September 2019 by Dr. Ravi K Dhar s/o Late Sh. D.N. Dhar r/o 239, Sanskriti Apartments, Sector 19-B, Dwarka, New Delhi-110075 hereinafter referred to as "THE SETTLOR" (which expression shall unless repugnant herein context or meaning thereof be deemed to include executors and administrators.

And whereas the settlor of the trust is desirous of creating a public Charitable Trust hereinafter called the **JIMS Vasant Kunj Alumni Association** for the purpose of developing a strong Alumni Engagement for nurturing a mutually beneficial relationship between the Institution and its Alumni

Whereas the Settlor has set apart in favor of the trust a sum of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) to form as a corpus fund for the said trust.

1. For effecting the said desire and in consideration of the premises the Settlor both hereby declare that he has prior to the execution of these presents paid, assigned, handed over and transfer into the Trustees the said sum of Rs 1000/- (Rs. One Thousand only). And all the estate, right, interest, property claim and demand whatsoever at all and in equity of the Settlor of in and to the said money and ever part thereof TO HAVE HOLD RECEIVE AND TAKE all and singular the said moneys into trustee upon the trustees and with subject to the powers provisions covenants conditions agreements and declarations herein after appearing and contained.
2. The trustees so hereby declare that they shall hold and stand possessed of the said sum of Rs. 1000- Rs. One thousand only)- which amount is hereinafter for brevet's sake referred to as "THE TRUST FUND" (which expression shall also include any claims, properties and securities or investments of any kind whatsoever into which the same or any part thereof might be converted, invested or varied from time to time or such as may be acquired by the trustees of come to his hands by virtue of these presents or by operations of law or otherwise however in relation to these Presents) upon the Charitable trust and with and subject to the powers, provisions, covenants conditions agreements and declarations hereinafter declared and concerned the same.

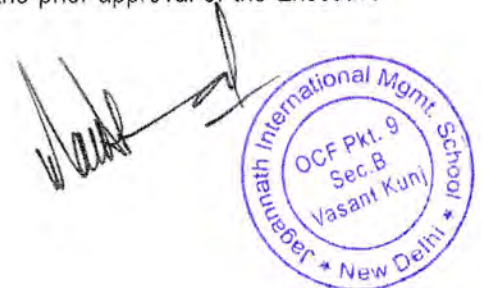
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3. The Trustee shall hold and stand possessed of the Trust Fund upon the following Trusts:

- i) To carry on community developments programs for the upliftment of the economically weaker sections of the society and other such activities.
- ii) To constantly update and maintain data of all Alumni Graduated / Post Graduated students of the various Programmes/ courses of the Jagannath International Management School, Vasant Kunj and coordinate interaction between the Faculty and Alumni. These interactions could be by way of establishing and maintaining libraries, reading rooms, vocational centers, placement aid centers and to take initiative in promoting general welfare of its members. The Association fosters the spirit of brotherhood and camaraderie among the alumni of the Institute. To build and sustain a strong belongingness to the Institute & students
- iii) To organize functions, seminars, conferences, classes lectures, workshops, industrial visits for the diffusion of knowledge for the benefit of members.
- iv) To enhance interaction between the members by organizing social gatherings. Publishing journals/ newsletters or through any such means by which this objective is met.
- v) To gather placement related information through the members or otherwise and disseminate this information as and when sought by the members.
- vi) To establish fund and/or grant scholarships and stipends, free ships and to hold competition and conduct research in respect of knowledge and skills in management, skills, arts, social and cultural activities and to conduct and participate in such activities.
- vii) To Print, Publish regularly magazines, reports pamphlets, leaflets, periodicals journals and books and to circulate these gratuitously or otherwise for the propagation and spread of knowledge.
- viii) The Association shall maintain a non – political character and independent identity at all points of time. The Association may however invite persons associated with various political parties or holding offices in the Government in the interest of the members of the Association, but without prejudice to its entity.
- ix) To acquire, construct and manage movable and immovable properties of the Association for the attainment of the stated objectives.
- x) To work for recognizing the Alumni achievers and further leverage their experiences towards inclusive growth of the institution.
- xi) To mentor existing students towards growth and rewarding careers.
- xii) To manage the trust fund and to collect and recover the interest, dividends and other income thereof and to pay there out the expenses of managing the Trust Fund and all other outgoing, if any.



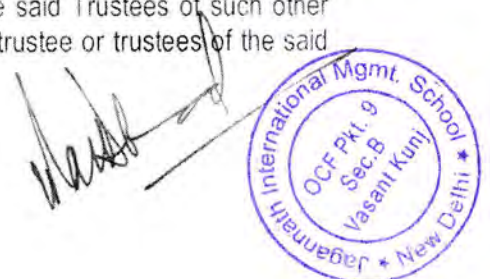
- xiii) To pay or utilize the balance of such interest, dividends and other income of the Trust Fund (hereinafter called net income) and accumulation thereof and at the desire of the Trustee the corpus of the TrustFund or any one more of following Charitable purpose in India or accumulated for application to such purpose in India without any restriction as to any particular religion community, cast or creed and in such shares of proportions and in such manner in all respects as the trustees in their absolute discretions deem fit PROVIDE ' HOWEVER THAT the net income as also the corpus be applied to the objects in accordance with the conditions and limitations, if any, as may from time to time be laid down in the Income Tax act 1961 and wealth tax Act,1957 or any other Act governing taxation of income or wealth as will ensure or make this trust and its income eligible for exemptions from taxations under the Income Tax Act1961 and wealth tax Act 1957 and or any such Act, governing taxation of income or wealth for the time being in force in India.
- xiv) To raise, subscriptions, Fees, Donation, Hundies, Admission/Registration Fees, etc., from self-help group and to grant loan to self help group and other association of persons in Village urban arrears in any state or union Territory of India for activities undertaken for Economic, Social and Education upliftment of its society.
- xv) To borrow from Central/State Financial Institutions, body corporate, Nationalized/ Scheduled Bank, Co-operative Bank, other" Govt. /Non Govt. Agencies, both in Indian or abroad for attainment of its objective with or without security of the moveable/immovable properties of the Societies/self help Group by way of Mortgage, Hypothecation Lien, pledge, of its fund pledge in fixed deposit or for as required by the lending in situation.
- xvi) To raise and manage funds by way of admission/participations/Subscription Fee, Membership fee, Subscription to specific funds, Loans, Gifts, Donations, Security, Instrument for and on behalf of the Association with the express approval of the Executive Committee.
- xvii) To invest and deal with the money of the Association not immediately required in such securities and in such manner as may from time to time be determined.
- xviii) To hire, employ or engage such persons as and when required for carrying out the above objects and to pay them such remuneration/fees as deemed fit.
- xix) To collaborate with, get associated or affiliated to or associate with any other Association or Organization with the prior approval of the Executive Committee.



- xx) All the income, earnings, movable and immovable properties of the Association shall be solely utilized and applied towards the promotion of its aims and no profit or thereof shall be paid or transferred, bonus, profits, in any other manner whatsoever to past or present members of the Association or to any person claiming through any members. No members of the Association shall have any personal claim or any movable or immovable properties of the Association or make any profit whatsoever by virtue of his Membership.
- xxi) To do all such other things as are incidental and conducive to the attainment of the above objects or any of them.
4. The name of the Trust shall be JIMS Vasant Kunj Alumni Association and the trust office shall be at OCF, Pocket 9, Sector - B, Vasant Kunj, New Delhi - 110070 and the following named Trustees shall mean trustees of the said trust.
5. a) The first Trustees of the trust shall be
- i) Mr. Prateek Misra, s/o Mr. B. P. Misra, r/o 346, POC-2, Sector-9, Shanti Kunj Apartments, Dwarka, New Delhi-110077;
- ii) Mr. Naresh Kumar Dubey, s/o Mr. Ravi Dubey, r/o WZ-300B/16, Ashram Lane, LodhiChownk, Palam Village, New Delhi-110045
- iii) Ms. Pallavi Dhingra, w/o Mr. Dhiresch Sachdeva, r/o M-14, Sainik Nagar, Uttam Nagar, West Delhi, Delhi-110059
- b) The Board of Trustees will ordinarily consist of not less than two and not more than twelve members. The First two trustees Mr. Prateek Misra and Mr. Naresh Kumar Dubey shall hold office for life. The life trustees may nominate their successors trustees for life, during their life time.
- c) The Trustees may 'co-opt': Trustees to the Board of Trustees, if necessary, to make the total number to twelve.
- d) The Trustees Co-opted shall hold office only for one year and are liable for retirement. The Trustees whose term of office expires again be co-opted by the existing Trustees. The Trustees may if he so desire, resign his trusteeship even before the expiry of the terms of his Trusteeship. The board of trustees may terminate any of the co-Opted trustees even before the completion of the term, if they act against the interest /objectives of the trust.



- g) To do such other lawful things as are incidental in carrying out the administration and management of the trust.
- h) The trustees shall maintain the Minute Book in which the proceedings of all meetings of the trustees shall be recorded by the trustees and same shall be signed by the Chairman of the meeting.
- i) The trustees may frame rules and regulations as to the duties and responsibilities of each Trustee, to appoint sub committees, mode of conducting any other matter connected with the administration of the trust and its management.
- j) That the funds/property of the trust will be used only for the objectives of the Trust.
- (k) In the event of the dissolution of the trust, funds/assets of the trust will be transferred only to some other trust/society having similar objectives.
7. The Trustee authorised by the Board of Trustees shall have the custody of all the documents, deeds of title relating to the properties and investment, and the books of account and other records relating to the trust and shall be responsible for the preservation of the same.
8. The Trustees may maintain a set of advisors for the purpose of utilizing their services in furtherance of subject of the trust.
9. The Trustees may for the time being reimburse himself or herself and pay and discharge out of the Trust Funds in his hands, all the expenses incurred in or about the execution of the Trusts of the powers of these presents.
10. If the trustee is engaged in any other profession or business, he or his firm shall be entitled to charge for his professional services including all profits, costs and charges in spite of the fact that he shall be a trustee are in the ordinary course of profession or not and although they may not be of a nature requiring the employment of a Solicitor or other professional person. If any trustee of these presents shall be broker or sub-broker, he or his firm shall be entitled to charge for his or their service including any brokerage payable to him or them.
11. It shall be lawful for the trustees at any time if he so desire, to transfer and hand over the trust fund to the Trust of any other institution which may take upon itself the duties of the administering and managing the Trust to the same power, provisions agreements and declarations as those appearing and contained in these presents subject to such modification (including the modification of the power of appointment of New trustee or of the class of beneficiaries) as may be necessary due to the said Trustees of such other institute or institution becoming or agreeing to become the trustee or trustees of the said Trust Fund.



12. The Trust hereby created shall be registered as public Charitable Trust with the appropriate authorities and for this purpose the Trustees hereby authorized to add, amend or alter any clauses herein contained if so directed by the said authorities at the time of such registration.

The Trust shall remain irrevocable for all the time and the Settlor do hereby declare that he has released, relinquished, disclaimed, surrendered, and determined and he hereby release relinquish, disclaim and determine all right or powers if any which may have been reserved to him either by the presents or otherwise in the Trust Fund and investment for the time being representing the same or the income thereof TO THE INTENT that the Trust Fund may be held by the Trustees upon the trusts and with subject to the powers provisions covenants, conditions agreements and declarations contained in these presents to the entire exclusion of the Settlor and of any benefit to him by contract or otherwise.

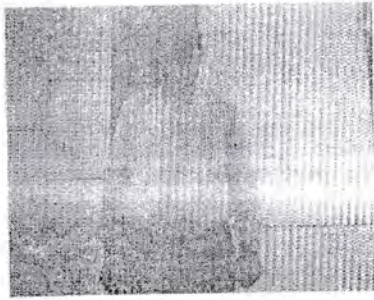

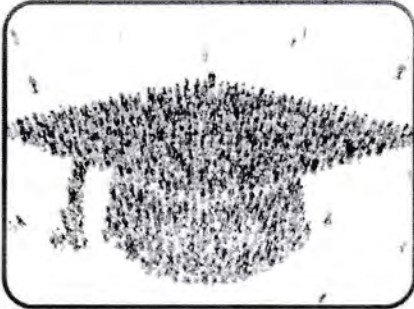
